

# **Cold Email Templates**





### **OUTREACH EMAIL TEMPLATES**

### How to use these templates:

- Use one cold template for an entire day's outreach, the next day switch to email 2, then switch to email 3.
- On day 4 send follow up email 1 to the cold email 1's, day 5 send follow up 2 to the cold 2's, day 6 send follow up 3 to the cold 3's.
- Make sure you reply to the cold emails when you send the follow up emails, this way the email chain will stay as one so the prospect can read both emails on the one trail.
- The idea is you are testing and measuring which cold and follow up combos work the best for replies.
- On day 7 you start working a new batch of leads following the same 3 days cold and 3 days of follow up system.
- Make sure you work alphabetically so you can sort your leads at the start of the day and start from the contact you last finished with the day before.
- Make sure you note on paper each time you send a cold or follow up emails so you can complete your end of day spreadsheet.
- Try to beat the previous days volume numbers so you get faster at your outreach.
- Update the CRM with new information you may find and remove dead leads.
- When a contact replies, mark in the notes on the CRM which email they replied to, for example write:

"Contact replied to Cold email #2"

Then always say what they replied and your next steps, for example:

"Contact asked for more information, so I sent them the link to the process and the round table sign up link. I have set a reminder to follow up with them in 2 days"
